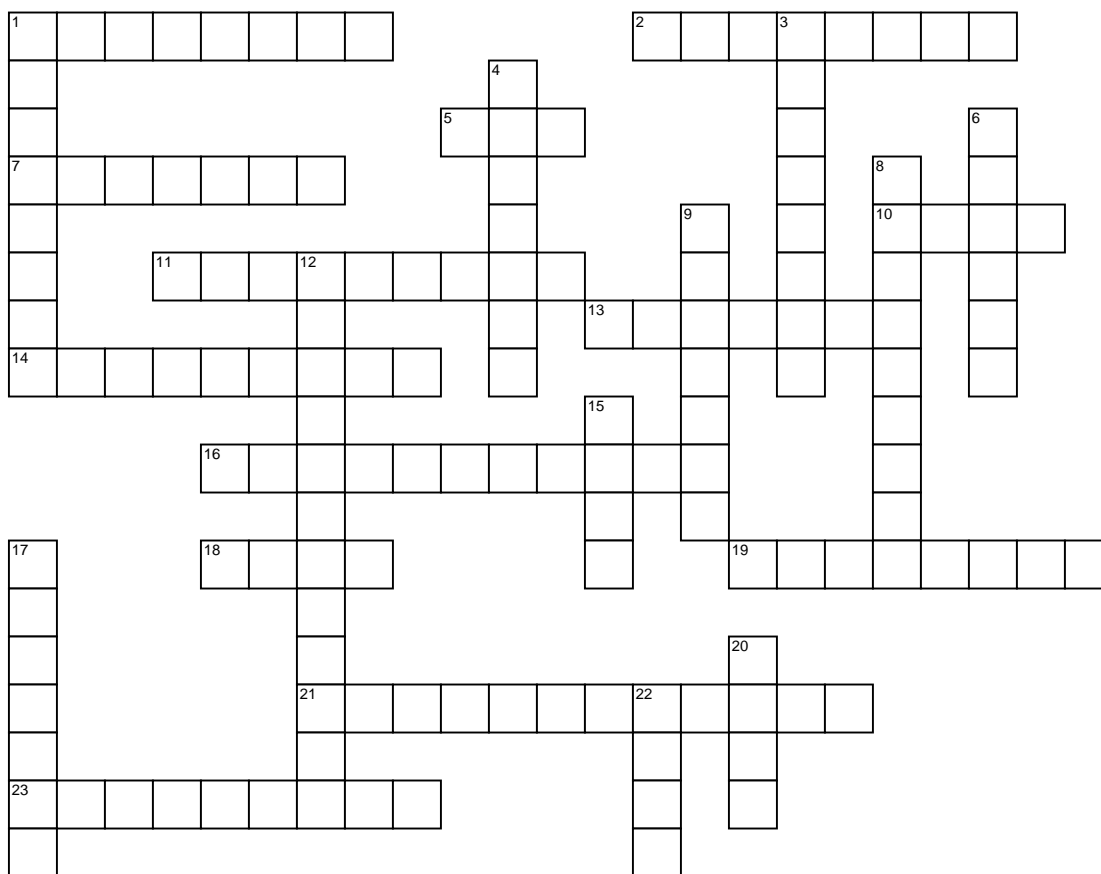


# Hoofcare Essentials® 101

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## ACROSS

- 1 A tool used to remove debris from the hoof/
- 2 Narrow, upright hooves with a small frog and closed heel
- 5 Area of the underside of the hoof on either side of the frog where the hoof wall angles in
- 7 Inflammation of the laminae of the foot
- 10 Hard, insensitive outer covering of the hoof
- 11 Term used to describe ground that is wet or soft
- 13 The part of the hoof above the horny growth
- 14 Inflammation of the laminae of the foot
- 16 Downward rotation of toe of coffin bone inside hoof
- 18 Fleshy pad on the underside of the hoof
- 19 Ossification of the lateral cartilage on either side of the coffin bone
- 21 Inflammation of the heels
- 23 Small bone within the hoof

## DOWN

- 1 Upper portion of the hoof that you see
- 3 Where the hoof or shoe hits the inside of the opposite leg
- 4 The horny-grooved inside of the hoof
- 6 Degenerative condition of the frog characterized by infection and blackening of the affected area
- 8 Soft structure on the underside of the hoof that delineates sensitive areas from insensitive areas
- 9 Skilled craftsman who cares for horse's hooves
- 12 A disease condition
- 15 Portion of the underside of the hoof from the frog to the front part of the white line
- 17 The act of fitting and securing shoes to the horse's hooves
- 20 Back portion of the underside of the hoof
- 22 The foot as a whole in horses
