

Scholarship Application

AAPF member Frank Reilly DVM of Unionville, PA has graciously offered to sponsor two farrier school students to attend the 2013 International Hoof-Care Summit in Cincinnati, Ohio. Each scholarship will be worth \$500. The funds may be used to pay for the Summit registration, hotel, and/or transportation costs to and from the Summit. The 2013 Summit will be held January 29 - February 1. Deadline for applications - November 15, 2012.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduate of a farrier school between September 1, 2011 and August 31, 2012 where the owner or instructor of the farrier school is a member of the American Association of Professional Farriers (AAPF)(*see list below), OR
- Applicant must be a graduate of a farrier school between September 1, 2011 and August 31, 2012 AND be a Regular or Student Member of the AAPF, OR
- NEW! Applicant must be currently enrolled in a farrier school program where the owner or instructor of the farrier school is a member of the AAPF.

Requirements:

- The applicant will submit an application which includes a statement describing why the student feels he/she should receive the scholarship
- The applicant will have his/her farrier school or instructor also submit a statement stating why the student should receive the scholarship

AAPF Board of Directors Re-Launches Published Papers Program

After announcing the "AAPF Published Papers Program" the Board of Directors asked the respective committee to reconsider the program and make recommendations for enhancing the program.

The Board of Directors has approved the committee's recommendations, including:

- Changing name of "Peer Review Panels" to "Case Study Support Panels" It will be the intent of these panels to offer their support to authors and provide suggestions for the betterment of their case studies.
- Changing name of "Published Accredited Professional Farrier" to "Accredited Professional Farrier Published (APFP). There will be no distinction between an author of a case study or instructional article.
- Offering up to 16 AAPF Continuing Education credits for an approved case study or instructional article.
- Creation of a Critique Sheet for both authors and the Case Study Support Panels to use when evaluating case studies. Authors should use this sheet to confirm that all parts of the case study are included.
